Jackson, SC—Memorial Services for Mr. James Frank Berry, 70, who entered into rest December 30, 2017 after a long battle with Lewy Body Dementia and Parkinson's Disease, will be conducted Friday afternoon at 3 o'clock from the Posey Funeral Chapel with Veterans Honors. Pastor Brandon L. Fulmer officiating. A private family interment will be held in Beaufort National Cemetery.

Mr. Berry was a native of Missouri and Iowa, having made Jackson his home for the past 17 years. He attended Bethel United Methodist Church. Mr. Berry served in the US Navy during the Vietnam War and was a member of the Phillip Taylor Memorial American Legion Post #97 in Jackson, SC. He retired as a Boiler Maker with Local 83 and enjoyed making stained glass, riding his Harley Davidson and most of all visiting St. Augustine Florida and Disney World. Mr. Berry was preceded in death by his parents Joe and Eleanor Berry; a brother, Bob Berry; his father-in-law, James Goodman, Sr.

Survivors include his wife of 20 years, Mary Beth Berry; a child, Zane (Jillian) Berry, Ankeny, IA; a nephew, David (Amy) Berry; his mother-in-law, Emily Goodman; two brothers-in-law, Jim Goodman, Chris (Terri) Goodman.
