Lester Robert Daddario, (age 86), of Suffield, husband of the late Annett Mascolo Daddario, passed away on February 26, 2015, in Suffield. He was born August 2, 1928, the son of the late Nicholas and Loretta (Ruffini) Daddario, and lived in Windsor for 56 years before moving to Suffield. Lester was a Navy veteran of [World War II](#), and the [Korean War](#). He served on the USS Kennebec, and was a life member of the USS Kennebec Association and frequently attended Kennebec reunions held across the country. Lester founded Daddario Bros., Inc., a construction company, after his discharge from the Navy, and was its President until he retired. He was affectionately known by his crew as the "Hawk." He was an Exalted Ruler of [BPOE #2060](#), the Elks Club of Windsor in 1969 and 1970. Lester is survived by two sons, Michael Daddario and his wife Jo Anne of Suffield, John Daddario and his wife Lainey of Enfield and their sons, Jonathan and Stephen Daddario, and by his daughter Karen Harding and her husband Nicholas of Windsor and their daughter Ann McHugh and her husband Tim and by his great-grandson Belden McHugh, and many nieces and nephews. He survived six brothers and three sisters; he leaves one sister, JoAnn Lightle of Sun City, California. He will be missed by all those who knew him. He was a good friend to many and was always willing to lend a helping hand. The funeral will be held on March 3, 2015 at 10 AM at Rose Hill Funeral Home, 580 Elm Street, Rocky Hill, Connecticut.
